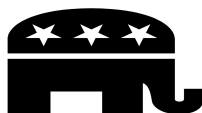

Scholarship Judging Criteria

The Republican Party of Franklin County, Iowa is offering one \$1,000 scholarship. The scholarship will be disbursed to one recipient in two payments of \$500 for two terms of work. Checks will be written to the recipient and the school. **Deadline to apply is Friday, March 31.** Applications should be **emailed** to Franklin County Republican Central Committee Scholarship Chairman Sharon Elling at sharon.elling@gmail.com. High school counselors **must also send hard copy duplicates** of all application materials to Sharon Elling, FCRC Scholaship Chairperson, Box 639, Latimer, IA 50452- with a postmark of March 31st or before. Material from all applicants from one school may be grouped into one mailing. The award recipient will be notified once a decision has been made by the Committee. Application criteria: • Franklin County resident • Applicant of voting age must be a registered Republican, applicants who are not of voting age must have a parent or guardian who is a registered Republican, or they may submit a letter of confirmation from a teacher or other informed individual who can verify the applicant's interest and support of Republican principles. Judging criteria: • Grade point average: must be such that would allow applicant to enter the postsecondary school and program of choice • Short essay on political and/or government interest along with any relatable experience • Short essay envisioning how an interest in politics might influence future endeavours.

In addition, applicants should be aware that such things as spelling, clean copy, legibility, standard grammar and the like may be factors if candidates seem equal while determining the award.
